## THE MANX ATHLETIC CLUB RUBY ANNIVERSARY

The Manx Athletic Club celebrates a significant milestone in its history this year, when it celebrates its 'Ruby Anniversary', or as the old song goes: 'We've been that the state of the s

together now for 40 years and it don't seem a day too much'.

It was on Monday, March 22nd, 1947 that the first moves were made to form the first athletics club on the Island, when a group of local enthusiasts met at 110 Bucks Road, Douglas, and at the request of one of the Island's best athletes, Bill Kelly, a committee was elected and entitled 'The Manx Amateur Athletics Association'.

The object of the Association was to place Manx Athletics on a firm footing, and with this in mind a meeting was arranged at the British Legion Rooms in Finch Road, Douglas on Friday, April 18th, and formal application was made to affiliate the club to the British Amateur Athletics Association.

At this historic meeting the rules of the Association were drafted and submitted to the English Northern Counties Athletics Association for approval, and the leading

club officials were elected.

The first President was Mr. George H. Drummond, who was a member of the Manx Government; the Chairman was Frank Large; the Treasurer Bill Cain; and the

Secretary was Bill Kelly.

The following month the Manx A.A.A. became affiliated to the Northern Counties and in a letter dated May 16th, 1947, the first official athletic club on the Isle of Man came under the guiding hand of the Liverpool District Committee of the Northern Counties A.A.

The club retained its Association title until the early 1960's, when it changed its name to the 'Manx Athletic Club', and it was around this period, on June 20th, 1962,

that a Ladies section was formed.

#### **First Track Meeting**

After about a year, when the club was feeling its way amongst the local sporting communities, the committee decided to organise its first Track Meeting. This was held at King George V Park in Douglas (before 'The Bowl' was built) on Tuesday, June 15th, 1948, and was a joint promotion with the local Cycling Clubs, with the posters proclaiming the 'Manx Athletic Festival'.

Before this track fixture the Manx A.A.A. organised its first Road Race, which was entitled 'The Round the Houses Marathon Race', over a route similar to that used for the Easter Festival Good Friday Road Races. In the 6½ mile Senior class the winner was Bill Kelly in 38 mins. 49 secs., while Doug Quirk won the Junior race over the same distance in 39 mins. 06 secs., while victory in the 2½ miles Boys race went to

Ron Somers in 16 mins. 50 secs.

Throughout the winter months of 1947 and 1948 the club organised Cross-Country training and racing sessions at Nobles Park, Douglas on Thursday and Saturday afternoons, and it was on April 9th 1949, that the committee decided to promote the first ever Island Cross-Country Championships. The venue for this epic event was Nobles Park, with the contestants racing over the 4½ miles Castleward Circuit, which covered the Tromode area. After a hard closely contested race it was Derek Miller who won the Championships by just two seconds from Eric Shimmin in 27 mins. 20 secs., with lan Quayle taking third place.

#### **Road Race Revival**

The club then decided in June 1949 to revive the Peel to Douglas Road Race which was a local long distance 'classic', which had a history dating back to the middle of the 19th century.

As expected it was Bill Kelly who scored a comfortable victory with a time of 61 mins. 30 secs., for the 11 mile course, which started at the Peel Football Ground and finished in Strand Street, at the Palais-de-Dance, which used to be opposite Marks and Spencers.

The next land-mark in the club's history came in May 1955 when, with the assistance of the Tourist Board, the Chairman Arthur Currie and Club Captain Bill

Kelly promoted the T.T. Course Road Race.

Victory in this race went to 1948 Olympic Marathon Silver Medallist Tom Richards of South London Harriers, who covered the 37 \(^3\)4 mile course in 4 hours 13 secs., with second spot going to Bill Kelly.

This race is still on the long distance road-running calendar, and the 33rd race in

the series will be held on Sunday, May 24th, this year.

The Manx A.A.A. then decided to organise a race over the Point of Ayre to The Sound route, and on Sunday, October 26th, 1958, the 'End to End Course' first appeared on the athletics fixture list.

On this day a seven man relay team covered the 40 mile route in 4 hours 8 mins. 7 secs., while Bill Kelly became the first and only runner to complete the distance in 5

hours 1 min. 4 secs.

The club was also committed to a Track-racing programme, and in the early 1950's was involved in weekly Meetings at King George V Park and then at Onchan Stadium, which they shared with the Cycling Association. In those early days the track programme catered for Senior male athletes only, with races on a grass track, over

100 yards, 220 yards, 440 yards, 880 yards and one mile.

Things have changed since the early days, with the club now promoting Track Meetings at Tromode, after sampling the facilities of the Bowl and the Ballakermeen School Field, but the surface remains constant — grass! Although the texture of the surface has not changed, the programme has altered beyond recognition, with male and female athletes being catered for in all the age groups from under 9 year olds to Veterans, and field events being added to the programme.

#### **Biggest Event**

Without a doubt the biggest event on the local athletics calendar is the Easter Athletic Festival, but it was far from a major fixture when the Manx Athletic Club promoted the initial event in 1962.

Only one visiting team joined the local clubs in competition, and in a seven man relay over the 40 mile 'End to End' course it was the visiting Wirral A.C. team who

came out on top.

The following year the club decided to use the Douglas 'Round the Houses' circuit for a five man relay, and this was the format until 1968 when the teams were reduced to four man.

Also in the mid 60's, the programme was increased by adding the Good Friday

Road Race, and a women's relay on Easter Saturday.

This move boosted the Festival and along with additional races added in the 70's and 80's, the Manx Athletic Club now has an event which is known throughout the length and breadth of Britain.

One thing is certain the whole spectrum of Manx Athletics and the Manx Athletic Club has changed since that initial meeting by a group of sporting enthusiasts some

40 years ago.

The only aspect which hasn't changed is the dependance of our sport on the enthusiasts who administer it at area or club level. To these pioneers from the past, and the present, and future officers of the Manx Athletic Club, we shall always be eternally grateful.
