Across bridge and continue right 80 yards then left up path at side of road, then left up hill to steep section, continue along flagged path to Marshal at fork, then up to the tower known as Corrin's Folly, at summit bear right past tower and down, flagged route to Farmer's Field, through field (flagged) to left hand corner then climb back up to tower and head downhill following flags but keeping to the right on the descent. At the fork in the path bear left taking a slightly different path to the foot of the hill and return along Quayside, to bridge, bear right and finish opposite Odin's Raven, in front of the Creek Inn.

At the fork in the path bear right taking a slightly different path to foot of the hill and return along Quayside to finish opposite Odin's Raven.


