FESTIVAL CLEAN SWEEP

Locals well featured in three day athletics spectacular

PHIL Mowbray of Edinburgh University's Hunters Bog Trotters and former ladies champion Lucy Wright of Leeds University's Doss AC dominated last weekend's Easter Athletics Festival, scoring three individual wins apiece.

Making his Island debut, Mowbray won the 5.389 mile road race around Governor's Hill and Willaston on Good Friday evening by some 15 seconds from Manx Airlines half marathon winner Pete Banks of Blackburn.

First local home was Gianni Epifani of Manx Harriers in sixth place, with Paul Clarke eighth and Chris Quine tenth.

Castletown's Robbie Callister, in his first competitive outing of the year, was the quickest veteran over 40 in 27th place, while Lucy Wright was the first woman home in 33rd spot, matching strides with local veteran Richard Radcliffe.

The latter man's Northern AC clubmate, Alan Postlethwaite, was the leading veteran over 45 in 40th position, with Karen Rushton the second woman to finish in 45th spot, one ahead of Steve Kelly.

Win number two came for both Mowbray and Wright in the following afternoon's hill race at Peel, where competitors and spectators were blessed with wall to wall sunshine.

Recenty returned from the World cross country championships,

chase on the initial ascent, Mowbray had the race in the bag by the time he commenced his descent from Corrin's Folley.

Gianni and Pete Banks had a sprint to the finish for second, a battle the Blackburn man won by just seven seconds. Paul Clarke and Chris Quine both made it into the top ten again, while Robbie Callister and Alan Postlethwaite repeated their veteran's class successes from the previous evening.

Lucy Wright won the ladies race by a clear 40 seconds from Doss AC team-mate Jo Dunstan, with Karen Rushton third and Manx born Sian Brice (nee Pilling) a good fifth in a rare local appearance.

Mowbray and Wright completed a cleansweep with further victories in Easter Sunday's 5km road race based at the NSC, but whilst there was no outright individual success for the local contingent, the Manx Harriers quartet of Epifani, Andy Fox, Quine and Clarke comfortably took the honours in the men's team relay.

Epifani finished fourth in the overall standings, Clarke seventh and Quine ninth, while Robbie Callister led the home domination in the over 40s, Alan Postlethwaite the over 45s, and Dave Corrin of Manx Harriers the over 50s

Running in the colours of her home town club, Southampton City, Karen Rushton finished runner-up to the impressive Lucy Wright in the ladies, with Sian Brice fifth, representing
