


Once again we are grateful for the continued financial assistance of the Department of Tourism without whose support we would be unable to offer the subventions.

= RULES OF COMPETITION =

 To be eligible for a team award a team must be made up of four 1st claim members of an affiliated club or belong to the same University past or present.
 Points are awarded for each team member in the race (i.e. 1st= 1; 2nd=2) the winning team is the team with the lowest score. In the event of a tie the result will be decided on the position of the 4th member of the team.

3. The overall team prize will be awarded to the team with the lowest score of points based on the team's positions. In the event of a tie the fastest team in Sunday's relay will win.

4. Individuals get the points equivalent to their finishing position in the race i.e. every male entrant in the race can win the senior mens prize. In calculating the Overall Mens Prize all the entrants are kept in the scoring order irrespective of whether they are a Senior Man, Veteran or Under 17 i.e. if a youth or Veteran finishes higher up in the race then the Senior Men who finish below them will have a higher score. Thus the lowest score no matter which category he falls in wins the overall prize.

5. Veterans and Under 17's will have separate scoring relative to each other in their races for their respective overall prizes. i.e. first Over 40 gets 1 point and second two etc.

6. No competitor can win more than one individual prize on any one day.

7. Teams for Friday, Saturday to be declared before 6.45p.m. on Friday (4 to run, 3 to score).

8. Teams and Running Order for Sunday to be declared on the Sunday before 10.30 a.m. Relay Numbers to be collected also on Sunday. Correct Number per leg must be worn (1 = A; 2 = B; 3 = C; 4 = D).

9. Teams must remain the same throughout the Festival.

10. Beer Drinking Teams to be declared by Sunday - 5.30p.m.

\equiv IMPORTANT INFORMATION \equiv

PLEASE NOTE: In all races, numbers are to be secured firmly so as to be **CLEARLY** visible at the end of each race. Numbers must be worn on **FRONT** of vest.

NUMBERS issued on the First Day to be used throughout the Festival (Except Relay Race – different numbers).

PLEASE NOTE: All athletes are requested to be at the starting line 20 minutes before their race starts. All times subject to alteration by Festival Director.

N.B. – Special Coaches leave for Peel on Saturday afternoon at 1pm prompt from Douglas War Memorial on Douglas Promenade and return at approx. 4.30pm. In addition a shuttle bus will leave Douglas War Memorial at 15 minute intervals from 9.15a.m. on Sunday morning, there will be no return bus. (Competitors and supporters are welcome to use this facility).


Ladies and Men's Race walk 5.3 miles Start Time - 6.45p.m.

Event "B"

Youths, Ladies and Men's Road Run 5.3 miles Start Time - 7.00p.m.

Course (2 Laps):

From TT Grandstand to Governors Bridge, turn left and proceed to entrance to housing estate (Gateway) on left, turn left and follow main road through estate, at T-junction turn left into Johnny Watterson's Lane and proceed down hill to cross roads, turn left along Ballanard Road take first turning on left into Keppel Road, take first right Baldwin Road run to end of road turn left 50 yards up road turn right into footpath and proceed to end, turn left into Glencrutchery Road and return to the Grandstand and continue for second lap.

EASTER SATURDAY Free Buses for this event leave the War Memorial, Douglas Promenade at 1.00p.m.

Event "A" Men 2.15p.m.

Start: Weatherglass Corner, Promenade, Peel.

Course: Along Quayside bear left at Creek Inn along Mill Road to bridge. Across bridge and continue right 80 yards then left up path at side of road, then left up hill to steep section, continue along flagged path to Marshal at fork, then up to the tower known as Corrin's Folly, at summit bear right past tower and down, flagged route to Farmer's Field, through field (flagged) to left hand corner then climb back up to tower and head downhill following flags but keeping to the right on the descent. At the fork in the path bear left taking a slightly different path to the foot of the hill and return along the Quayside, to bridge, bear right and finish opposite Odin's Raven, in front of the Creek Inn.

Event "B" Ladies 3.05p.m. approx.

Start: Weatherglass Corner, Promenade, Peel.

Course: Along Quayside, bear left at Creek Inn along Mill Road to bridge. Across bridge and continue right 80 yards then left up path at side of road, then left up hill to steep section, continue along flagged path to Marshal at fork, then up to the tower, known as Corrin's Folly, at summit of hill. Touch tower wall (Marshalled) and head down hill following flags but keeping to the right on the descent. At fork in the path bear right taking a slightly different path to foot of hill and return along Quayside to bridge, bear right and finish opposite Odin's Raven, in front of the Creek Inn.

Buses for Douglas depart at 4.30p.m.

\equiv EASTER SUNDAY ===

A Free shuttle bus will leave the War Memorial, Douglas Promenade every 15 minutes from 9.15a.m.

Composite Men's Teams are permitted on the day but are not eligible to win a relay team prize. Individual leg times will count for overall Festival Points.

Event "A" Ladies 5kms Road Race - start time 10.15a.m.

Event "B" Mens 4 x 5kms Road Relay - start time 11.15a.m. - Teams to be declared by 10.30a.m.

Course: Start on running track at National Sports Centre, leave by Marathon Gate and proceed round the perimeter road to exit, turn left onto main Castletown Road, follow road to left turn along road to T junction turn left to traffic lights turn left along road to Quaterbridge Hotel, proceed round corner back into Castletown Road using pavement. Do not enter NSC, but proceed on second lap of road course. On return enter National Sports Centre and turn left around perimeter road re-entering track at Marathon Gate.
