As the races start and the problems begin to arise, as they are almost bound to be in an event of this magnitude, I know that "Uncle Eric" will be gazing down on the busy scene and keeping his fingers crossed, wishing each and every one of us the best of luck.

He often said to me that no-one was indispensable, all I know is that we will all miss this "Gentleman of Athletics" and the gap left by his sad passing will be very hard to fill.
